
The FreeSpace® DXA 2120 digital mixer/amplifier easily can be configured into one of three operating modes for greater flexibility with business music system applications:



(1) Mixer Mode – Each input can be routed to every output simultaneously. The simple front-panel control allows easy gain adjustments for up to four microphones. Control volume for each channel independently, or use master volume to control both outputs at the same time.



(2) Dual Mono Select Mode – Two input sources are available for each output channel. Volume control and source selection are available in each zone.



(3) Stereo Select Mode – Two stereo sources can be connected to a single output zone. Volume control and source selection are available in the zone.
